



1st Activity

On September 21, 2021, the consortium partners had a progress report meeting. There were three main directions for discussion. The first one was devoted to sharing and reflecting the generalized survey results, IQA indicators and setting the roadmap for further project implementation. The second direction was devoted to start of the work package 2 of the project. That included the work package overview, consideration of tasks and deliverables and setting a timeline and deadlines. The third direction was mostly about project coordination and managerial issues. Russian NEO preventive monitoring results and financial administration matters were discussed and further steps were suggested.

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2nd Activity

On September 23, 2021, a round table on the topic "Independent quality assessment of educational activities: tools, results, best practices" was organized and held on the basis of Tver State University (TSU). The purpose of the round table was to discuss and generalize information about the quality of higher education, popularization of the best practices of quality assurance including results of the IQAiAR survey report on internal quality assessment. The round table also discussed topical issues related to the development of the national qualifications system, the development of modern technologies for ensuring and evaluating quality assurance procedures for education, and the improvement of state accreditation procedures. Following the results of the round table, it was decided to form communication platforms at the university to discuss issues of ensuring the quality of education, a discussion analysis of the results of an internal independent quality assessment, dissemination of experience in organizing internal procedures for assessing the quality of student learning.



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3rd Activity

On September 27, 2021, the Institute of Pedagogical Education and Social Technologies (IPOST) of TSU hosted a round table "Professional achievements and difficulties in the activities of a young teacher as guidelines in assessing and managing the quality of pedagogical education for primary schools." The participants of the round table were heads of educational organizations (employers) and young teachers (professional experience up to 3 years) graduated from TSU. The event was moderated by IQainAR TSU team members A.V. Belotserkovsky, Director of the Center for Strategic and Innovative Development; I.D. Lelchitsky, director of the IPOST; L.A. Katauskaite, head of the Quality, Licensing and Accreditation Department. As the result, the typical difficulties in the professional activity of a novice teacher were summarized, which set grounds for further improvement of the internal quality assessment and management in pedagogical education.
